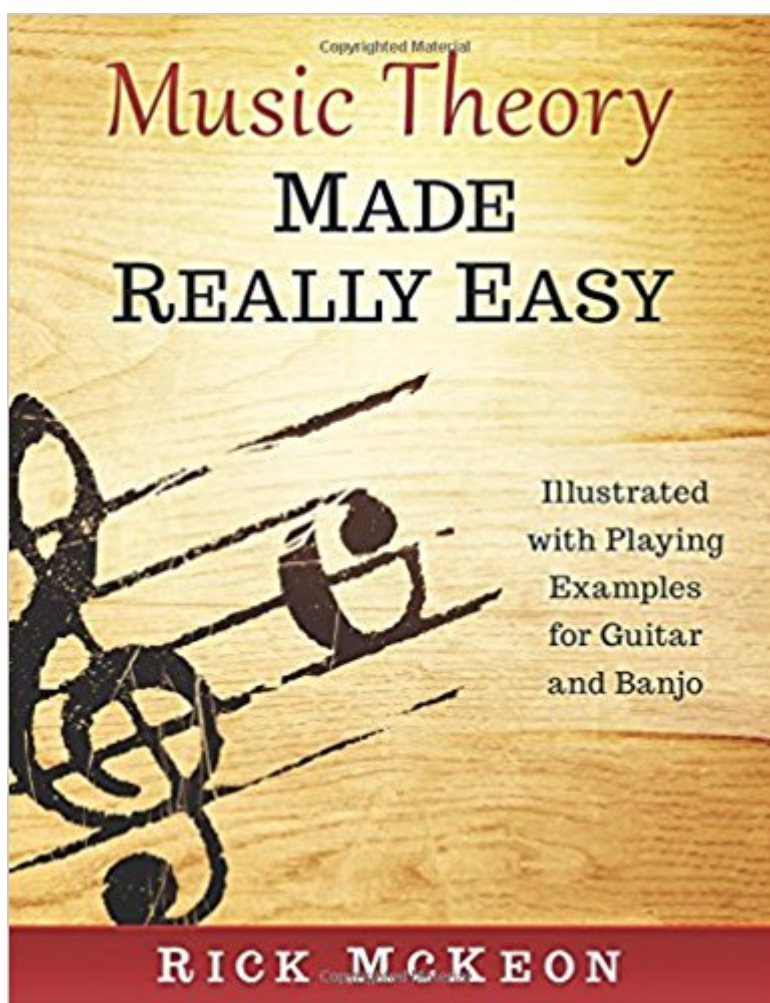

I was excited when my package was open revealing Rick McKeon's book *Music Theory Made Really Easy: Illustrated with Playing Examples for Guitar and Banjo*. The cover is really nice and promises accessible knowledge for those starting in music or for those who want more. After I scanned the table of contents I went through every page one at a time. There is a lot of knowledge in it. I know that I don't know a lot of music, but now I have a good idea how much, but that's okay for Mr. McKeon explains much. What he demonstrates are: what are major scales, what are thirds, what are perfects, and why they are important and a whole lot more. He even explains what the Nashville Number System is, (something I've been a little curious about). And yes, he keeps it simple while showing where is on the banjo and guitar. Even though it is in black and white it is really beautiful. Color would distract and is more with Mr. McKeon's goal of keeping it simple. As I was reading scanning this book ideas and possibilities started coming to me. I am going to be referring to this book in the by and by.

Not new to music but new to learning the terms. I cannot read sheet music and that is not big liability, but the terms and fundamentals are needed. That is a gap that this book filled well for me.
