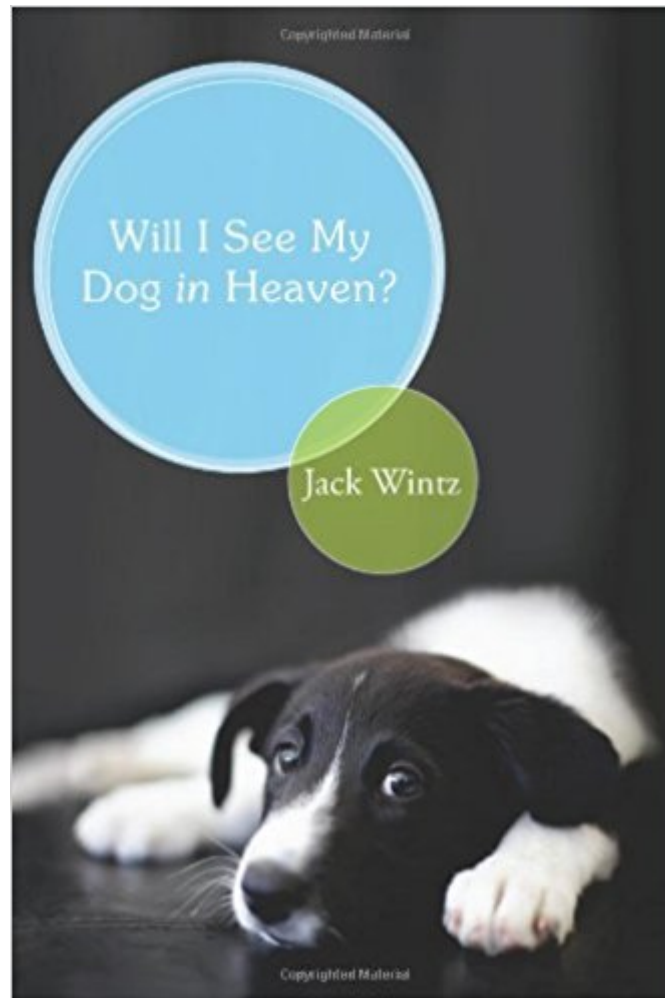

As a practicing Catholic, I have always dismissed the old Catholic teaching that only humans went to heaven. I love animals, and I simply refused to believe that God would create such wonderful

creatures only to take them away from us forever. I believe, as does Father Wintz and Francis of Assisi, that the divine exists in all of creation. I am so grateful for this book!

Based on the Church's tradition, scripture and life of St Francis, Jack Wintz makes a powerful case that we will see our pets in heaven. For example, in the creation story, if God saw that what he created in the original paradise, not only humans but plants, animals and all of nature, was very good, then why would he exclude them from the final paradise? I would recommend that anyone who has lost a beloved pet or even has a living pet to read this encouraging and hopeful message based on sound principles.
