

So I have been waiting for this since Captivated by a Lady's Charm, we are finally going to find out the Duke of Blackthorn story and I am ecstatic that it is finally here. Lily Bennett has received nothing

but pain from the Winters family and after being cast on to the streets by the man who promised to love her, only to be tricked into becoming a mistress to a man she learned to hate, but finally Sir Henry died and yet again Lily's chance at freedom has been stripped away from her. Now she is being blackmailed yet again, this time she is being threatened in to stealing a diamond from the family she hates more than anyone— the Winters. Derek Winters, the 8th Duke of Blackthorn used to be an easy going jolly fellow, until the war happened. A war that caused burns to scar his face and turn that once fun loving guy into a man that hated life and the everyone in it. But things go from bad to worse, when he is left as the guardian of his niece Lady Flora and now has to put up with people in his home that is until Lily turns up demanding to become Flora's governess and turns his whole world upon its head. I truly loved the characters, Lily broke my heart! As Lily and Derek begin to breakdown the walls that protect their hearts, the find a love that could bring forgiveness and healing to each other. However, an enemy from the past threatens their new found happiness and take everything from Lily and Derek. This is truly and beautiful and heart-wrenching love story and one not to be missed!

I wasn't sure, after the glimpse of the bitter Duke in book 2, that I would like this gentleman. I was wrong, he is quite likeable. The relationship that develops between the Duke , Lily and Flora is lovely and real. Though Lily enters the home to have some revenge, he steals her heart, as does his young charge and niece . As he finds himself drawn to her, he begins to feel again, and finds himself. She also sees the man he is, not the "beast" the rest of the world sees. This is a story of love and triumph, it touches the soul and lifts the spirit, even through the sadness as the story develops. A wonderful gift of a novel.

Starring two protagonists who have experienced a world of tragedy, Rescued by a Lady's Love is a lovely beauty and the beast story. Lily has been so hurt by those she loves, first the peer she thought would marry her, then her family who shunned her and lastly by her protector who used her and made no provisions for her. She is destitute. When her protector's son asks her to steal from the infamous Derek Winters, the new Duke of Blackthorne, in exchange for a house and money, she agrees. After all, the Duke's family were the catalyst that sent her life on a tailspin. She will gain entry into his home as a governess to his young ward. Derek was a soldier and his face and upper body were severely wounded when his friend's rifle exploded near his face. He has become a recluse hiding his scarred face but even worse his soul has festered and he has become angry, embittered and short tempered. Lily and Derek square off initially and Derek is amazed that this beautiful woman stands up to him. He is equally impressed and fascinated. Slowly he lowers his guard and opens up to Lily. Lily is so torn. What began as revenge is morphing into something else

entirely. Lily sees beyond the scarred visage to the lonely man, who is just as lonesome as she is. Her generous heart takes in Derek and his ward and even more she wants to heal Derek's broken spirit. Her compassion is admirable. Yet always lurking is the threat of discovery. There is so much emotion and fire between the leads. These two need each other. It becomes obvious to the reader early. Their journey is a good one and both characters are well written, their thoughts and actions make perfect sense. There is heartache in this story but joy too and the way they reach for each other is both touching and impassioned.
