

I love the works of this author and I love the Jeremy Logan series, but this topic (werewolves or their relatives) wasn't as gripping for me - hence three stars vs. what would otherwise be 5 stars. It's an interesting take on the subject, fully developed as are all Lincoln Child's works, and read to completion. I look forward to the next book in the Jeremy Logan series!

Starts a little slow, but quickly speeds up. Keeps your interest till the end. Unfortunately, there seems to be only a few ways the wolf man stories get resolved, therefore it became easier to figure out the ending as it approached. Would have liked to have seen a different more creative ending. Oh well, can't always have everything. Still a good read.

I'm happier when Preston and Child write together, but occasionally I've enjoyed the stories they write alone. I find Child's better...more interesting and believable. Preston's are always "far out." I'm glad I bought this book. It's a good read.

I am a huge fan, and have read all of Mr. Child's books. This one felt too much like a rehash of so many other werewolf novels. If you're looking for a great Lincoln Child book, try the Forgotten Room. I couldn't put that one down.

Another unsatisfactory effort by an author I used to enjoy immensely. Well written, with developed characters, but the plot is obvious from the start. Not at all worth the full cover price I paid.

I have read almost everything Child has written, with & without Preston. This didn't disappoint. If you can handle some gore, it was really suspenseful. He painted a picture of the deep, dank forest so

well, I felt I was there!

Full Moon is moonshine at its finest. It combines elements of the supernatural, suspense, and mystery in a novel that has no slow moments. Fans of the writing duo of Lincoln Child and Douglas Preston will enjoy this novel.
