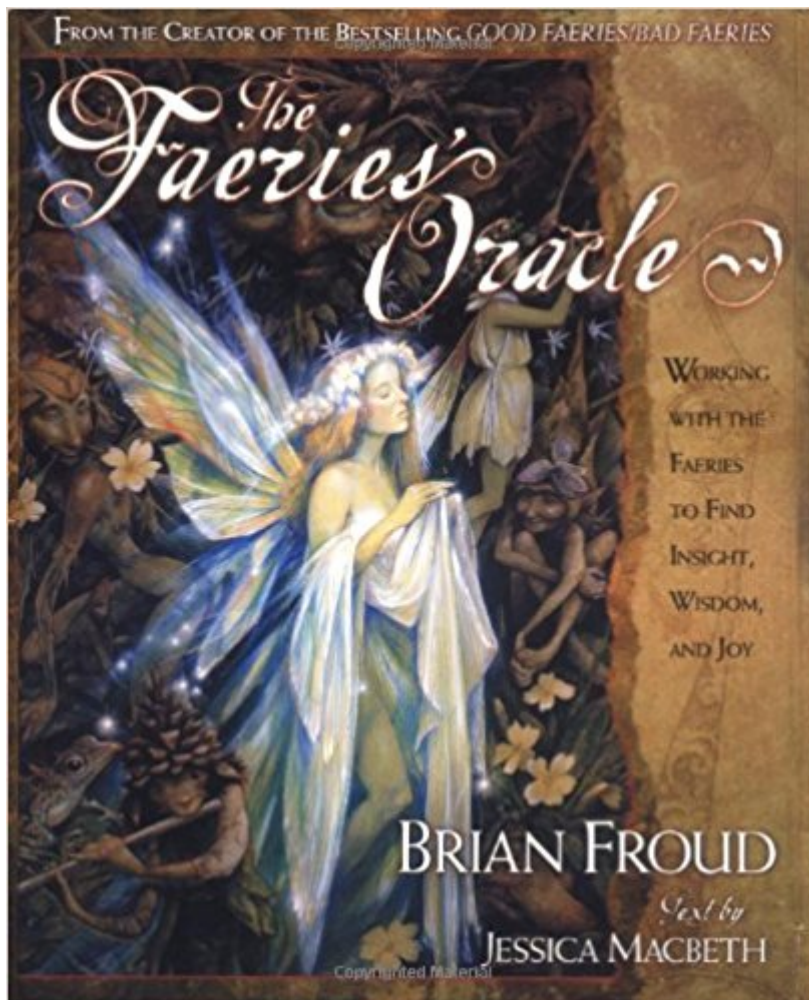


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The Faeries' Oracle

Author and illustrator Brian Froud offers believers a chance to consult with the magical wee folks. Using a deck of 66 "oracle cards," believers conduct readings as if interpreting Tarot cards. Each of the cards features Froud's signature faery pictures. Some of the cards have specific faeries, like the naked leaping "Spirit Lancer"--a feminine card that represents "self-expression, freedom, and exploration," according to the accompanying text written by Jessica Macbeth. Others are more abstract, like the "Guardian of the Gate," a blue-tinted card with splaying silver-white streaks that look like tendrils of faery hair. This fascinating deck will keep Froud fans delighted for hours. Once

seekers are ready to actually start communicating with faeries, they will also be delighted with Macbeth's whimsical, yet highly informative, guidebook. She is quick to sympathize with the self-consciousness that comes with talking to faeries, yet she also has the ability to jolly people out of their embarrassment. Macbeth is at her wisest when discussing how to ask for guidance and interpret specific layouts of oracle cards. But if you find yourself succumbing to giggles in the midst of all this faery woo-woo, take heart. Writes Macbeth, "Giggles are the grace notes of faery music."

The art of the deck is so pretty and soothing. I like looking at it and just studying the art. The book is fun and written in a very friendly tone. Its the type of book that gently guides you and cheers you on. I have an issue with the quality of my cards though. They weren't cut properly, they cut into the pictures. I don't like that at all. It makes the cards feel cheap and shoddy. It wasn't all the cards but at least four or five. That's my only issue and it makes me want to buy a new deck. But I've become attached to my current deck which is surprising and I rather get the new cards to replace the poorly cut one.

Long time favorite book and set of cards. I recently purchased this set for my husband, and we ooo'd and awww'd over the artwork for a whole evening. Brian Froud is one of my absolute favorite visual artists. If you love the fae, or even just appreciate unique and beautiful art, you will adore this.

If you're into faeries then this is the most interesting deck that I have found as it includes pixies, gnomes and animals. It comes with a detailed book that teaches you how to "connect" with the cards to interpret them how you view not just how to read them from a book.

Beautiful, unique artwork. Soulful write ups on each card. Very Fae. The card interpretations are deep, addressing the Light and the Shadow of whatever issue you're dealing with. Very psychologically based. If you believe in Faeries, this is the deck to purchase.

I love the deck and book. However the card stock is awful. I will probably have to get a back up copy. The deck is worth having but it needs to be treated very gently if you want the cards to last.
