

Love this and the other series by this author, highly recommend this book and all the others for a totally great reading experience.

The author's writing style flows well enough, and that's probably the main strength of the book. I wish characters and the story were more developed and didn't feel so by-the-numbers predictable. It's inoffensive (if you don't mind sex scenes of course) but not memorable, nor gripping enough to continue the series.

Aegis, the emerald Dragon watches over the metal jackets as they adjust to their new life. They decide to form a contracting company, Rent A Dragon, to keep the new dragons busy as handymen as they each search for their mates. Kate is their first customer and Liam is sent to her house for the job and a simple handshake has Liam's inner Dragon shouting MATE! He's amazed after finding her so quickly. Each day Kate is more and more attracted at first not believing that this gorgeous man would want someone like her. Liam is already protective of her when another dragon shows up at her door! How can he protect Kate when she's stubborn and independent and drives him crazy with wanting to take things slow. And how will she react when she finds out that he really is a dragon? What do rogue dragons want with HIS mate? You'll have to read it to find out! Terry Bolryder has once again started out with a great series starter. I can't wait to read what's next!

There is not as much excitement and adventure in this story as in other dragon books by Terry Bolryder, but a nice escalation with a little action. Liam is cute, hardworking and willing to do anything to win his mate once he finds her. There is another dragon who comes into the picture, but I won't say more, so I don't give it away. Read the series in order if you prefer to have them happen in chronological order: Double Dragons (super hot and action-packed), Tiger Protectors (very similar to Double Dragons), and then the Awakened Dragons, which takes place right before this series. If you like dragons, hot scenes, good character development and some cute pets, then you will love these books. This series is a little milder in heat and action, but still quite good. Try them and see. Enjoy!
