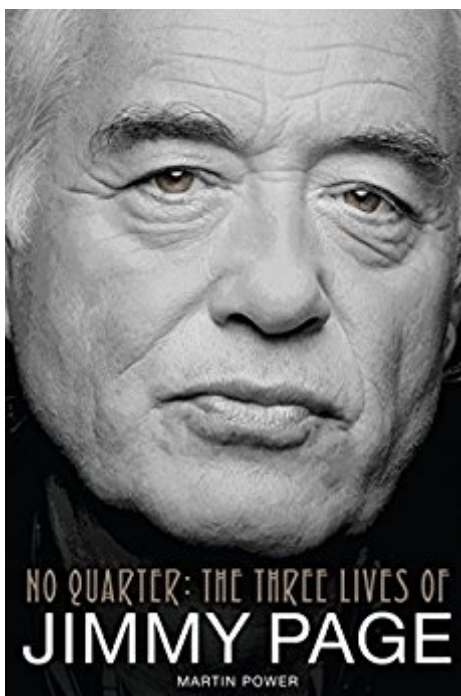

Hardly a day goes by where I don't spend some time listening to their music and it never fails to strike just the right 'chord' of reminding this 67 year old just how great it is to be young once again and put a smile on my face knowing that I was living through the best of times. I was surprised upon it's arrival at the length of the book, but after reading it I understand why it spans nearly 700 pages. There's just so much to cover in order for the author to provide a big picture view of what all went into this guy becoming who he is and accomplishing everything he did. I knew Page had a great deal of creativity as an artist before reading the book, but I didn't realize the extent of how much the highs and lows, breakthroughs and frustrations from experiences as a sought after session player helped define Page's yearning and vision for something bigger and better, and how much he was willing to take on for the opportunity to see it realized. Whether one loves Jimmy Page, loathes him, or somewhere in between, the picture Power paints of his three lives is a pretty incredible story.
