

Arlene has made huge contributions to the fiber artist community with her Spin Artiste online blog and as co-creator of Fiberygoodness.com, Arlene has been instrumental in the development of creativity courses for fiber artists, and in supporting the growth and development of others in this field.

This book is so much more than I expected. Not only is it a beautiful book filled with photographs of everything it talks about it is jam packed with information. The instructions are all written so that a beginning spinner who is just starting to get interested in processing or re-processing fiber will understand. It is a completely accessible resource on everything from basic color theory to the most popular tools to very detailed spinning instructions and even some examples of finished objects. It does focus on rainbows throughout but the information is just as applicable to any other color combination. I definitely would recommend it for those who are just starting to take a look at re-prepping purchased fibers but still need a lot of hand holding. Those who are veterans of fiber prep might not draw too much new information from it but there is always the eye candy throughout. Spinners should note that all the spinning instructions are written for wheel spinning. Spindle users will need to make some adjustments in order to produce the same type of yarn but it is definitely possible in all cases.

Beautiful book! This is a wonderful book. Suzy Brown and Arlene Thayer have done a great job helping people learn more about fiber. There is a lot of practical advice on how to get more out of your tools and problem solving. It has information on color theory and blending. Spinners, Felters and many types of Fiber Artists will enjoy this book. The photography is lovely too.

It's called the Big Book of Fibery Rainbows!!! That's a big promise and this book does deliver! There aren't many spinning fiber preparation books out there, but this one is certainly worth adding to your library. It is very comprehensive, including lots of different techniques. The photos are pretty and inspiring. I'd say the book is especially good for beginners, as a general reference book or those

needing a refresh of skills. Serious experts might not find any advanced content here.
