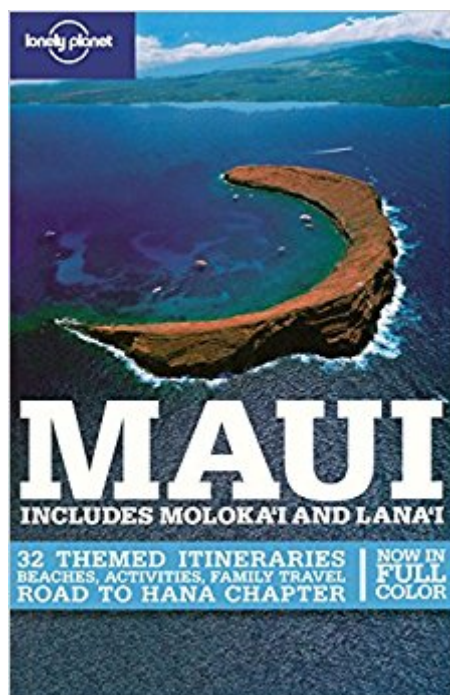

Very well done. Looks like a new type of format compared to most Lonely Planet books but I like it.

I'm going to open by saying this is a nice travel guide book. There are color pictures, descriptions of the different things tourist would be interested in, maps, and themed itineraries. The color pictures are nice (especially for Maui) for giving an idea of the environment. Readers can easily see that areas of Maui are very steep with lush colors. However they did fail to show the rather drab coloration of the Kona coast. The location descriptions are nice, I know from their *Hawaii: The Big Island (Regional Guide)* a travel guide accurate and I'll assume accurate for Maui also. The maps are rather basic, but then Maui doesn't have the road networks other places might have. As for the themed itineraries, they seemed nice if you were doing one of the themed items, but I wouldn't limit myself to what they identified. Arguably the best part of the book was the gray pages in the back. These pages give good insight for tourist on what to expect in general, what to do, and how the locals are; very important when you're the guest (in my opinion). Rating-wise this is a solid 4 star travel guide. Lots of interesting descriptions sometimes with a little opinion of their reviewer (several were humorous) making it a little more personal than other travel guides might be. While I enjoyed that, I really wish they'd included webpages for the different items. Knowing where to get a restaurant's menu or a hotel's page on line can make a big difference on if I want to go there. Also, things change between publication of travel guides and when we go and visit them. Include the webpage so people can look things up ahead of time and use the travel guide while they're traveling.
