Morgan Rice keeps increasing the excitement and suspense in the 7th installment in this series. I'm a huge fan of the Sorcerers Ring series by Rice so I thought I'd give this series a try. Over the past two weeks I have read all 7 of these books, loving each one more than the last. Ceres, Thanos, Sartes, and Stephania are well-rounded characters. They aren't always likeable, especially Stephania, but they feel like real people facing real challenges. If you are a fan of the Sorcerers Ring series, Narnia, or the Princess Bride, give this series a try.

As I said in the headline this book just didn't have the balance his others books have. It was constant battling with hardly any interacting of the characters.
