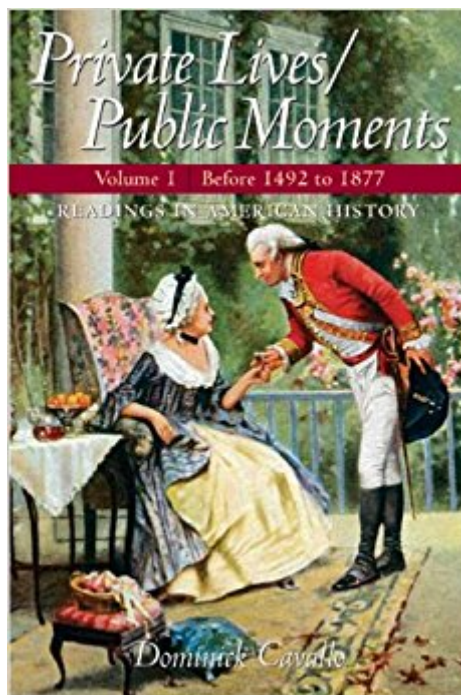




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Private Lives/Public Moments: Readings In American History, Volume 1 (to 1877)
