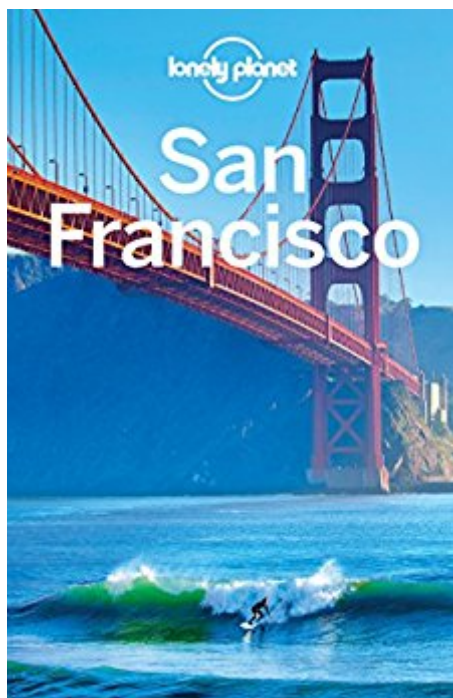

However, it would be better if Lonely Planet expands this to include the whole Bay Area or even just a section on Silicon Valley since those areas are interlinked. And chances are, you'd also be visiting other areas south of SFO aside from the places mentioned in the guidebook like Napa and Sausalito, which are mostly on the Northern part.
