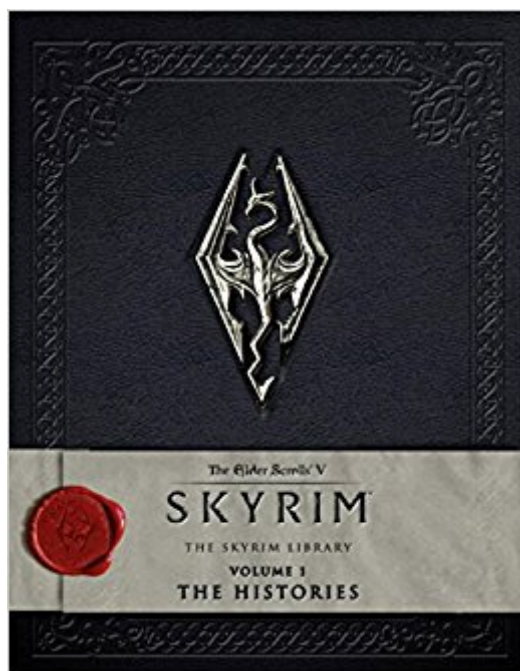


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The Elder Scrolls V: Skyrim - The Skyrim Library, Vol. I: The Histories

Whether you're a fan of the game Skyrim or The Elder Scrolls Universe as a whole, this book is certain to make a fine addition to your physical Elder Scrolls Collection.
