Interesting and terrific book that addresses many teen struggles. The characters are relate-able and their angst feels common. I like the characters and appreciate how we get to know another character better. This book and the first, Catholic Reluctantly, have a wonderful way of sharing Catholic doctrine and bringing it to life without preaching. Situations more than anything help to express Catholic doctrine in a way that teens will understand it and most likely think about it. Good teen fiction.

This is book 2 of the John Paul 2 High series (although you most likely knew that because it says so on the cover of the book). There are some more ethical things discussed, mostly about revenge and what would be a just war in the eyes of the Catholic Church. George, a protagonist, does some things one should never do, but regrets it later on. (I don't think that a big spoiler or anything). The only thing that bugs me is that Allie was rude to Celia (and it bothers me when anyone is rude to Celia) a couple of times, and sometimes she mistreated George. Overall, though, it was a good read.

I LOVED the first book, Catholic, Reluctantly, and thus far, I am very excited about (and grateful for) this series. This second book, Trespasses Against Us takes on more mature themes. It handles them beautifully, but they were certainly too mature for my 14-year old homeschooler. My mistake was not reading the book before allowing my daughter to read it. Again, the author(s) dealt with the themes very well, but they were just a little bit more than my 14-year old needed to be exposed to, yet. Thank you for this series! I am looking forward to more books.
