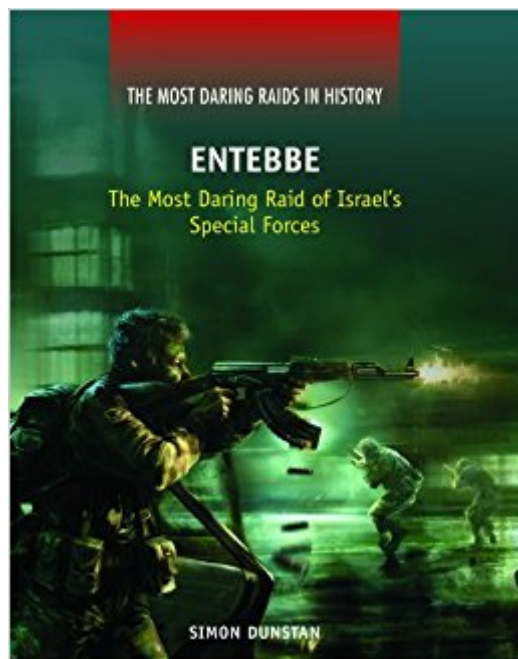




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Entebbe: The Most Daring Raid Of Israel's Special Forces (Most Daring Raids In History)
