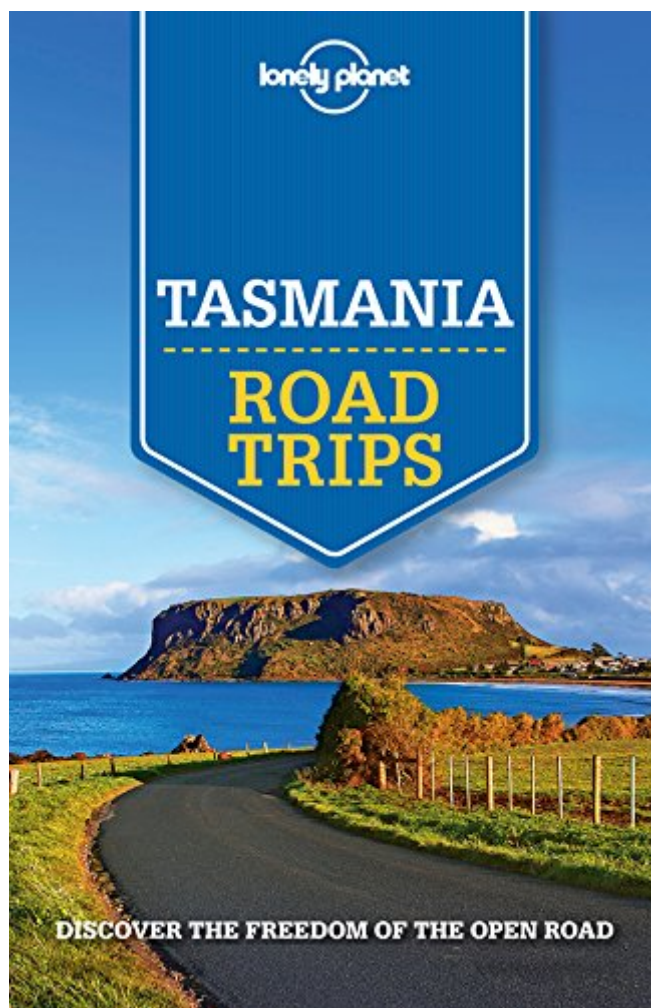

My wife and I recently returned from a month-long trip to Australia and spent the first week of that in Tasmania. It was one of the most beautiful places I've ever been (over 20% of the island has been designated as World Heritage sites). However, it is not as big a tourist destination as many other parts of Australia and many of the other guidebooks don't give an in-depth look at the island. This book was indispensable in planning our trip. Its descriptions were complete, accurate and informative and the advice it gave as to certain sites (many of which are located in state or national parks) proved very useful. I recommend that anyone planning a trip to Australia seriously consider adding at least several days in Tasmania and then buying this book.
