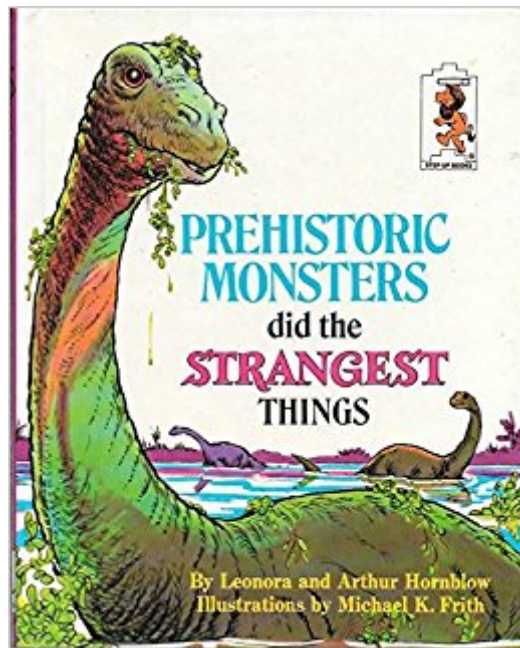

For some reason, my 9yo daughter loves the "did the strangest things" series. I owned a "Fish Do the Strangest Things" from my childhood, and she read it over and over. She saw the other titles listed on the back of the book cover and asked me to get them (they are all out of print and our library didn't have them). I found all of them 'used' on . When we got to this one --Prehistoric Monsters do the Strangest Things-- I told her maybe we shouldn't buy it because science has learned so many new things about dinosaurs since the 1960's--but she wanted it anyway, There wasn't too much I noticed that was outrageously out of date (just content or new theories that were absent) so we'll supplement with more modern books, documentaries, etc too. It is a very nice series--easy to read but not dumbed down.

We started with "Plants Do Amazing Things," and have progressed through more titles. These books are well-written, engaging, and spot-on for elementary readers.

I remember checking this book out from the school library when I was in Elementary School. I loved this book. It brings back memories. I bought my own used copy from .com a while ago so I can read

this book at home anytime.

I read these when I was elementary age and have bought this series for my children. They are excellent! Large easy to read type and keeps kids entertained while imparting information. Well worth purchasing.
