


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# Injectable Fillers In Aesthetic Medicine

This is an invaluable and concise manual on proper patient selection, identification of the problem (most important !), and appropriate injection technique for aesthetic facial enhancements. As a board certified plastic surgeon, I've seen multiple examples of poor injections, poor planning, and poor patient selection. Weekend courses and cookbook instructions for facial fillers are seductive for the inexperienced injector, but often lead to undesirable results. This book teaches how to "see" the problem and correct the deficiency. Warning signs are well elucidated. Many important "pearls" are located though out the book.
