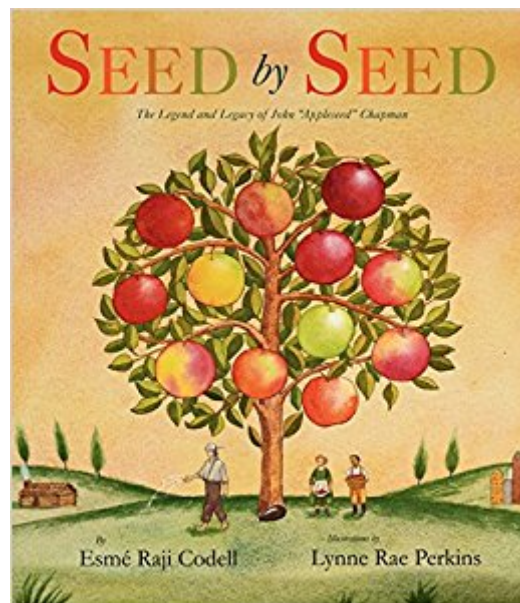

Meh. Don't get me wrong, this book has great illustrations and figurative language, for example: "The moon shone on the snow until the land glowed like a pearl." I even like the beginning of the book where the author tells how the past is different from the present and the pictures show a little boy and girl in modern times and then their surroundings and clothing change to the time of John Chapman. I thought that was cool. It is a really pretty book, I just can't get over the spiritual undertones, which make it seem so hokey. "His sweet spirit lives on in the apples we eat..." and

there is a little chant at the end of the book you are encouraged to say and you can use the word, "Lord", or "World", or "Earth" interchangeably in it if you wish. It's not terrible, I just can't read it to my kids without feeling silly. We will be using a different book to learn about John Chapman/Johnny Appleseed.

I am a speech-language pathologist, and bought this book to teach my elementary students and middle school students about the importance of Johnny Appleseed. This book is not written for either of these populations, and the information presented in the book does not captivate it's audience (teacher or student). If you are a teacher or professional looking for a good Johnny Appleseed book, I would NOT recommend this book.

This is an interesting and long book. Not quite like a storybook although it does start out that way, this is more of a miniature encyclopedia to my thinking with page after page of fact and detail (be it legend, fact or myth). The illustrations are wondrous to the eye and enjoyable to look at and my favorite page is one that is embroidery with words around and in it. Johnny Appleseed is always a great learning theme for school and I'm glad to have discovered another book for our shelf.
