

Mindie Burgoyne's Haunted Eastern Shore is a nicely creepy collection of ghost tales from one of the most haunted regions in America. The Eastern Shore of Chesapeake was one of the first places of European contact more than five hundred years ago, and even before then, the first inhabitants were up to spooky doings. From old estates with tragic tales (money can't buy happiness, but it can

create spirits with unfinished business) to the hustle and shake of garish Ocean City, ghosts are just about everywhere in these parts, and Mindie's here to tell their spine tingling stories. Highly entertaining and informative for those interested in the supernatural right down to the serious ghost hunter, this is a book worth adding to your collection.
