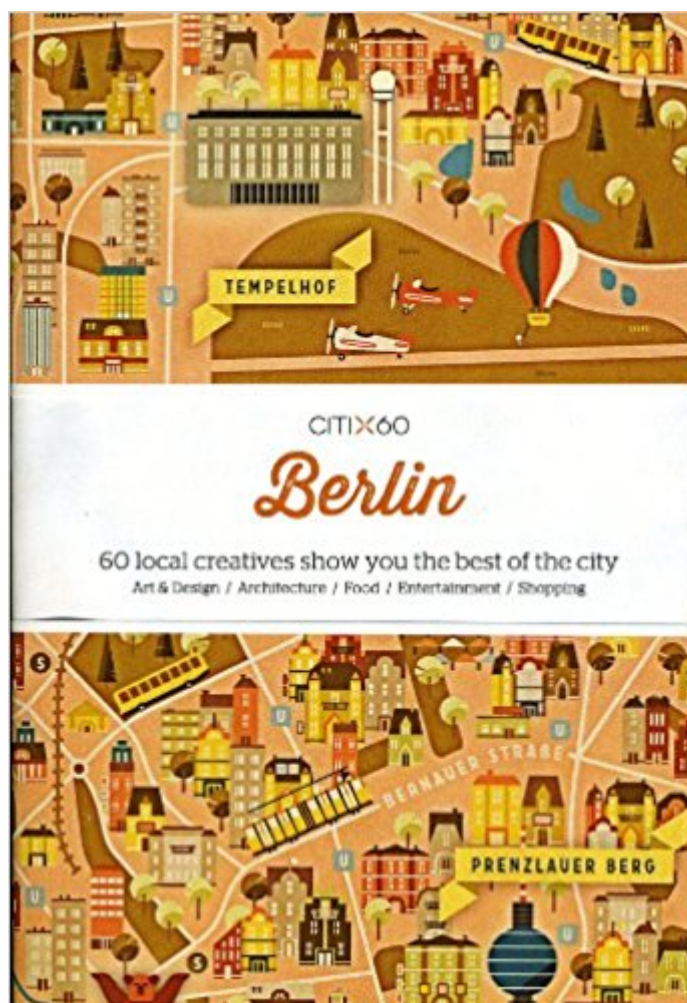

The CITIX60 series provides guides to some of the world's most renowned design hubs - cities that lead the world in culture and design. Curated by a select group of local artists, designers, chefs, architects, musicians, photographers, and filmmakers, this is an insider's view of what makes a trip to his or her city memorable. With up-to-date recommendations on the accommodations, eateries and shops that give a city its distinctive flair, and a handy section on travel tips that gives basic information on getting around, as well as usual tours and recurring festivals to consider. Detailed maps and QR codes provide ease of travel, and a blank pages section at the back with lined and gridded pages allows for note-taking and sketching.

It was interesting to me to see what they would select to recommend. It is a bit amateurish, but on the positive side, it's like having a friend who lives there tell you their favorite hangouts and what they imagine a foreign tourist would appreciate. For example, one enthusiastically recommended

restaurant sounds tiny, and assuming many people read this book, we might be standing in a waiting line with a few tourists for quite awhile, not how you want to spend your valuable sightseeing time. I'd call it charming, (esp the English!) and it certainly gave me a couple of tips to think over on the east side. So some definite value for the price can be found even for someone who used to know the city well, and more, I assume, for someone who has never been. I'd get a broad-spectrum Berlin book to accompany it.

This book wasn't too helpful, I just spent a week in Berlin and didn't get much value out of it. It reflects the biased opinions by young locals about their favorite haunt. Unfortunately, I often had the impression that their recommendations were in support of businesses with whom they had a personal relationship. The guide isn't organized by location so is difficult to reference when you are in the city. Many of the places mentioned are small and out of the way, destinations not worth the effort. I'm hesitant to buy any other guides in this series as a result.
