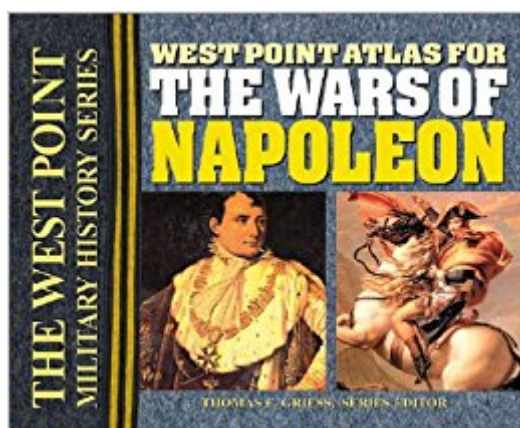

Covers Napoleon's campaigns many at the operational and strategic level. The color registration is off slightly on some maps (the overprinting is a little visible). As other reviewers have noted, a

history/description is needed in order to understand the maps and why the various arrows went where they did. Naval operations and operations outside of Europe are touched on, but the focus is on Europe. Update (6 Nov 2014) Just noticed that Napoleon's name was misspelled on the spine. Sloppiness there makes me wonder about other errors. They lose a star.
