

Since 1973, Rick has spent about four months a year exploring Europe. His mission: to empower Americans to have European trips that are fun, affordable, and culturally broadening. Rick produces a best-selling guidebook series, a public television series, and a public radio show, and organizes small-group tours that take over 20,000 travelers to Europe annually. He does all of this with the help of a hardworking, well-traveled staff of 100 at Rick Steves' Europe in Edmonds, Washington, near Seattle. When not on the road, Rick is active in his church and with advocacy

groups focused on economic justice, drug policy reform, and ending hunger. To recharge, Rick plays piano, relaxes at his family cabin in the Cascade Mountains, and spends time with his partner Trish, son Andy, and daughter Jackie.

If you are planning a trip to Spain and want to do it educated on what is there, this is a great book. My wife and I have taken a trip to Italy using only the Italian book from Rick Steves. It worked so well, we are not going to do it again in Spain. Everything is in it. Plan to pack ultra light and make the experience fun.

I love Rick Steves. I really do. I would buy his book just to show him how much I like his videos, which I watch for free on youtube. But the kindle version of the guide, when viewed on an android phone, is difficult to navigate and images cannot be enlarged. I found myself squinting a lot and thumbing endlessly through pages. Maybe this is a kindle format issue. The contents are good, and Rick's theory of travel aligns well with mine. I would buy the paper book instead.

Rick Steves books about travel to Europe are consistently the best book to use. It concentrates on the places tourists are most likely to visit and covers them in depth. The city walking tours and museum collection highlights are extremely helpful. Once you use any Rick Steves book, you never will use another.

I don't really care for Rick Steves' show but his travel guides are second to none. I've used the France, Austria, Germany, and now Spain books. I love that he provides suggestions for lodging, restaurants, and most importantly guides. Because of this book, we hired a recommended guide for our day trip into Tangier. After being there I can't imagine doing it without a guide!!

Rick Steves' travel books are my bible when planning a trip to Europe. I used them in 2012 and 2015 and got the latest editions for an upcoming trip to Italy, Spain and Portugal this fall.
