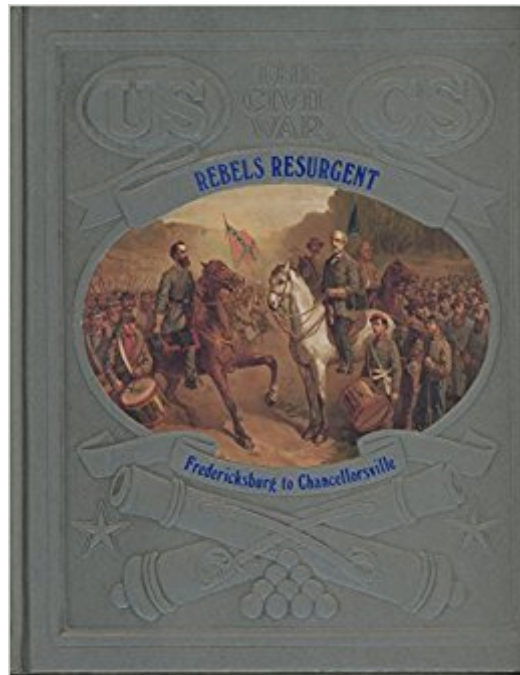




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# Rebels Resurgent: Fredericksburg To Chancellorsville (Civil War)
